

Transporting Gas Cylinders Safely

The training contains information on:

- Relevant legislation

- Threshold limits
- Transport categories
- Load transport units
- Mixed loads
- Warning signs
- Emergency procedures



At the end of this online training workshop learners will be able to:

- Recognise the need to select the correct type of vehicle
- Assess their load in respect of the relevant legislation
- Determine the transport category for the gas(es) they are transporting
- Determine the transport units applicable to their gas cylinders
- Calculate their load's Total Load Transport Units to identify whether it is above or below its threshold limit
- Take the appropriate action before they start a journey transporting gas cylinders
- Determine what personal protective equipment they require
- Recognise the need to stow cylinders correctly
- Assess the ventilation within the vehicle
- Describe the actions to be taken in the event of a road traffic accident
- Introduce safer working practices into their workplace
